

# HYGIENECONCEPT

## Distance, hygiene and everyday masks

- Keep 1,5m distance, avoid physical contact
- Maintain hand hygiene (especially thorough washing of hands), observe coughing and sneezing labels, avoid sharing objects or clean them after use (e.g. tablets and keyboards of computers)
- General mask obligation on entire school premises, except when sitting at a desk in the classroom
- Air the rooms regularly
- If possible, groups should not be mixed
- Possibilities of special measures are examined for persons with underlying diseases
- Mute smartphones with activated Corona warning app (remain in school bag during lessons)

## Three – Step - Plan

According to the hygiene – framework – plan for schools in Bavaria

Three – Step – Plan with the aim of enabling the longest possible attendance in class even when the infection situation deteriorates

1. Regular operation under hygiene conditions with a seven-day incidence up to 50 (threshold value of infected persons per 100.000 inhabitants in the district)
2. (not relevant for primary schools)
3. The introduction of a minimum distance of 1,5m in the classroom for a seven-day incidence of 50 and over (limit for class division and the alternation of face-to-face and distance learning)

For a quick changeover to a possible hybrid teaching, the school has developed a concept with the following core elements:

1. The design of distance learning and the participation in online lessons are regulated in a binding way
2. The interaction between students and teachers will remain intensive and regular
3. Rules for online learning are set.

## PROCEDURE IN CASE OF ILLNESS

According to the hygiene – framework – plan for schools in Bavaria

Persons may not enter the school if the:

- Are infected with the Corona virus or show corresponding symptoms
- Are in contact with an infected person or less than 14 days have passed since the last contact with an infected person
- Be subject to any other quarantine measure

Procedure in case of cold or respiratory symptoms:

- In case of slight, newly occurring symptoms (such as a cold and occasional cough) school attendance is only possible if no fever has developed after at least 24 hours (from the onset of the symptoms).
- Sick pupils in reduced general condition with fever, cough, sore throat or earache, severe abdominal pain, vomiting or diarrhoea are not allowed to go to school. Re-admission to school is possible again in stages 1 or 2 only provided that the students have been symptom-free for at least 24 hours (except for slight rhinitis and occasional cough)
- It is obligatory that the student was free of fever for at least 36 hours
- In level 3, admission to school or re-admission to school is only possible after presentation of a negative test for Sars-CoV-2 or a medical certificate.

## PROCEDURE IN CASE OF A CORFIRMED CASE OF COVID-19 DISEASE

According to the hygiene – framework – plan for schools in Bavaria

- If a confirmed case of Covid-19 disease occurs in a school class in a student, the entire class will be excluded from class for a fortnight and quarantine will be ordered by the responsible health authority. All students in the class are tested for SARS-CoV-2 on day 1 after detection and on days 5 to 7 after initial exposure.
- Teachers who are tested positive for SARS-CoV-2 as well as affected students have to follow the instructions of the public health department. They have to go into quarantine and are not allowed to hold face-to-face classes. The extent to which students or other teachers have to stay in a 14-day quarantine is decided by the responsible public health department depending on the individual case.

# WEARING A MOUTH-AND-NOSE COVER

What you should consider

This must be observed:

- Mouth and nose must be completely covered
- The mask can be removed for eating and drinking
- Face visors, valve masks, multifunctional and neck scarves are not permitted
- If someone has forgotten his/her mask, please contact the class teacher or Miss Elena or Miss Claudia immediately to pick up a replacement mask

Ensure proper handling, especially:

- It should be flush and tight at the edges
- Avoid to touch the mask as far as possible
- It should be cleaned properly and regularly and stored in a clean place
- It should be changed two or three times a day, depending on how damp it is

## REGULAR AIRING OF ROOMS

All balcony and terrace doors have to be opened as far as possible for at least five minutes, namely:

- Before the start of a lesson
- During the lessons at least every 20 minutes
- In every break

# TOILET USE

Generally during lessons

Toilets should always be used during lessons:

- A maximum of three people may use the toilets
- Please follow the instructions for washing hands

## TEACHING STAFF

Teachers set a good example

- Wearing a mouth-nose-cover-mask
- During the first two weeks of the school year on the entire school premises for all adults, i.e. also in the staff room

During the rest of the school year with the following exceptions for teachers:

- In the classroom at an appropriate distance from the students
- In the staffroom, if the appropriate distance can be maintained
- In the staff room at the respective assigned place
- For sports teachers, the locations of the respective sports lessons
- Regular ventilation of the staff room



# CLEANING OF THE SCHOOL BUILDING

- Hygiene in sanitary areas
